Jeff opened the meeting at 7:12p.m.

Roll was taken. Jeff Eisenmenger, David Moore, Steve Scott, Jason Ramey, Judy Misiniec (non-voting member) and Bill Barrett (Attorney). Absent Betty Davis

David Moore led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Bill Barrett introduced that the Trafalgar Town Council was required to elect a President and Secretary for the Finance Committee.

Wendy Blackwell presented a Wastewater Credit for Justine Swagler for \$22.57. Jeff made a motion to credit Ms. Swagler's account for \$22.57. Jason 2<sup>nd</sup>. All in favor. Motion passed 4-0.

It was also discussed the number of customers who are currently using on-line bill pay.

Donna presented the Trafalgar Town Council Special meeting minutes from January 4, 2016. Jeff made a motion to accept. David  $2^{nd}$ . All in favor. Motion passed 4-0.

Stormwater payment No. 2 for \$194,294.41 was presented. Bill wanted to find out this amount was before or after the retainage fee. Jeff made a motion to approve the payment to Dave O'Mara for the amount of \$194,294.41. David  $2^{nd}$ . All in favor. Motion passed 4-0.

Discussion on resident at 601 E Park St, Trafalgar In, and Town will send letter to resident to comply with Town's Ordinance on trash and litter violations.

Discussion on yellow house on Main St. (Pearl St), Bill Barrett will send letter to resident regarding violations and legal compliance. Charles will take pictures and send to Bill.

Lance Fisher asks the Town Council if residents could use the Town Hall to hold a forum with Solar Farm Hoosier Energy. Town Council did not see any problems with using Town Hall Conference Room. Mr. Fisher also presented he was writing letters to the State Highway

Department regarding a stoplight at Joes Junction, because of safety issues with this intersection.
